General Rules and Details

1. General

The Club has several sets of rules that outline various issues relating to Club operations and how we expect members to act. The Club is run on a friendly `family` theme where we feel that rules are for guidance when needed, but we appreciate that the Club has certain legal and moral obligations that have to be set out in Rules and Regulations.

The Club has the following General Rules and requirements, plus specific rules for Boat and Car sections. These cover the `etiquette` required at the track and on the water to ensure that all activities are fun and safe for all involved.

2. Constitution

The Club's Constitution outlines the main criteria for the Club's existence and operation.

No Junior Member (under the age of 18) may be elected as a Club Officer or Section Representative.

3. Child Protection Policy

The Club has a legal obligation to publish a Child Protection policy. Although you may not have children of your own, the Club has members under 18 whom you may come into contact with. You must therefore ensure that you are familiar with this policy and how it operates.

Junior members (under the age of 18) must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or nominated responsible adult when partaking in Club activities.

4. Insurance

Club membership includes cover for you for Public Liability when engaged in Club organised meetings and activities at Gang Warily and elsewhere in the UK and for when you are operating "on your own" at Gang Warily pond but not elsewhere.

This Insurance DOES NOT cover:

- a) Damage or theft to your car/boat or associated equipment.
- b) Model Helicopters, for which you will need to arrange your own insurance. Club Membership in this section requires that a copy of your valid Insurance is kept on file with the Club's Membership Secretary.

WMC do not run model aeroplanes, whether Electric, IC, Jet, Glider or any other form. WMC do not run any other vehicle that uses an IC engine with an open propeller such as an Airboat.

Closed Electric driven propellers such as those used on hovercraft are acceptable and on specific occasions, IC model cars can be run out doors.

Members, guests and visitors using the Club facilities do so entirely at their own risk. The Club will not accept any liability for injury, loss or damage to property which is not covered by the Club's Insurance Policy.

5. Locations

The Club operates at the Gang Warily Leisure Centre Main Hall and Lake. Other venues may be organised as a Club event or via liaison with other Clubs or associations.

6. Meetings

The Club Calendar outlines all meeting dates for the Car and Boat sections together with the dates of the Officers Meetings and AGM. Only Club members are allowed to vote at the AGM.
